Report Of Special Programme For Slow Performers For The Academic Year 2021-2022

Criteria for assessing the performance of the students:

1. For clinical subjects/clinical year students- End posting clinical, theory & practical exams.
2. For non-clinical subjects/ non-clinical year students- monthly pre-clinical, theory & viva exams.
3. Three internal assessments examinations that are conducted throughout the year.
4. Personal assessment of the student by the teacher during clinical/non-clinical hours while performing on clinical cases/ preclinical models etc...

Students, by the end of each internal assessment are categorised as slow learners if they score less than or equal to 50% marks and as advanced learners if they score more than 50% marks in the above-mentioned criteria for assessment.

Special programmes for improving performance of slow learners:

1. One to one monitoring and attention.
2. Separate classes apart from regular classes with individual subject faculty.
3. Collaborated study with advanced learners.
4. Periodical assessment and evaluation.
5. Case based learning.
6. Rapid review course of syllabus prior to university examination.

Special programmes for encouraging & maintaining advanced performers:

1. Encouraging intercollege participations.
2. Assigning projects and helping students for publication writing.
3. Allotment of clinical cases with increasing complexity
4. Seminar presentations.
5. Encouraging to read & refer additional standard books and articles.

An assessment test was conducted at the end of the remedial classes to all the students similar to university examinations and the result is attached here in.
