CLEANLINESS AWARENESS AND DENTAL SCREENING CAMP

SUMMARY:

The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Kims Dental College, arranged a camp that included routine dental screenings and a strong message about living a life that is uplifting and encapsulating the notion of cleanliness. There were 130 men and 70 women out of a total of 200 participants that were screened. The age range of the tested population was 25 to 45. The universal screening results showed an extremely high prevalence of dental caries, chronic generalised periodontitis, and dental plaque-induced gingivitis.

SUMMARY:

By putting the old saying "PREVENTION IS BETTER THAN CURE" into practise, it became clear that entering the dangerous world of tobacco abuse would lead to a downward spiral of declining financial stability and negative health. They were given an academic explanation of the range of illnesses brought on by tobacco use in order to dispel any lingering doubts they may have had about the subject. The importance of resolutely avoiding peer pressure and staying away from this prohibited road was also emphasised.

There were 55 women and 75 men in the 130 participants that were screened. An age range of 16 to 40 years was present in the population that was screened. An extremely high prevalence of dental caries and dental plaque-induced gingivitis was observed, which is in line with the screening results' broad findings.

The amount of tobacco consumed in India has substantially increased. Teenagers are now acquiring harmful habits at younger and earlier ages. To raise awareness of the harmful effects of tobacco, the Department of Public Health Dentistry organised a camp at a private engineering college in Yanam. The pupils were between the ages of 18 and 24. A total of 200 of them were investigated. There was dental caries in 55% of the kids.
